**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that the South Coast AQMD is considering the adoption of Proposed Amended Rule 1135 – Emissions of Oxides of Nitrogen from Electricity Generating Facilities (PAR 1135). The objective of PAR 1135 is to partially implement the 2022 Air Quality Management Plan (AQMP) Control Measure L-CMB-06: NOx Emission Reductions from Electricity Generating Facilities. PAR 1135 will establish oxides of nitrogen (NOx) emission limits for electric generating units located on Santa Catalina Island. PAR 1135 includes monitoring, reporting, and recordkeeping requirements for electric generating units located on Santa Catalina Island.

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that PAR 1135 will be submitted to the California Air Resources Board and the United States Environmental Protection Agency for inclusion into the State Implementation Plan.

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that a written analysis pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 40727.2 has been prepared that identifies all existing state and federal air pollution control requirements, all existing and proposed South Coast AQMD rules and regulations, and all air pollution control requirements that apply to the same equipment or source type as PAR 1135.
